approved by the Government decree in 2010

THE CRITERIA OF THE LTQF LEVELS

- activity complexity
- performance independence
- activity variability

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE LTQF

- design of sectoral qualifications standards
- design of the national descriptors of study fields in higher education

LEVEL 5 IN LTQF (LEVEL DESCRIPTOR)




- integrated coordination of activity tasks in different activity areas
- evaluation of the competences of lowerqualification employees and training thereof

- various specialised activity tasks in several different activity areas
- performing the activities independently and supervision only as regards the evaluation of results

supervising the activities of lowerqualification staff, plans and assigns activity tasks, oversees the performance of the activities, provides consulting and verifies the performance quality.

colleges and VET institutions

At the same time, there are pilots of VET programmes at this level, implemented jointly by HE colleges and VET institutions. Art's School implements level 5 programmes for ballet dancer and contemporary dancer qualifications

SHORT CYCLE STUDIES IN THE LAW ON SCIENCE AND HIGHER EDUCATION

Short cycle studies - a degree of higher education for obtaining a professional qualification

Colleges issue a **study certificate**

The volume 90 or 120 study credits

Short cycle study programs must comply with the sectoral qualification standards and higher education study benchmark statements

30 or 40 credits of the programme should be awarded for students' **internships in a real** workplace.

Colleges and VET institutions may implement joint short cycle study programs

Enrollment criteria at least upper-secondary education or a professional qualification acquired after finalizing level 4 VET programme.

Fasade insulation master modular VET programme

Bricklayer master modular VET programme

Vehicle repair technician modular VET programme

Entry requirements to these programmes: relevant level IV qualification and 3-year practical work experience

Duration of programmes: 50 ECVET credits

Programmes are aimed at developing professional competences and transversal competences

Programmes are implemented by HE colleges and VET providers



Recommended criteria for making decisions about the paths of qualifications

Short cycle study programmes

- Activities requiring more academic-vocational knowledge based on applied and fundamental research (e.g. health professionals)
- Activities related to the introduction of technological, organizational and social innovations (e.g. junior engineer, technician, innovation manager)

VET programmes

- Activities requiring special vocational knowledge and a higher level of practical skills (e.g. provision of services, organization of production)
- Activities related to the use of technological, organizational and social innovations
- · Prior practical professional experience is a prerequisite
